

# S.R. 12; Passing Lane Connection

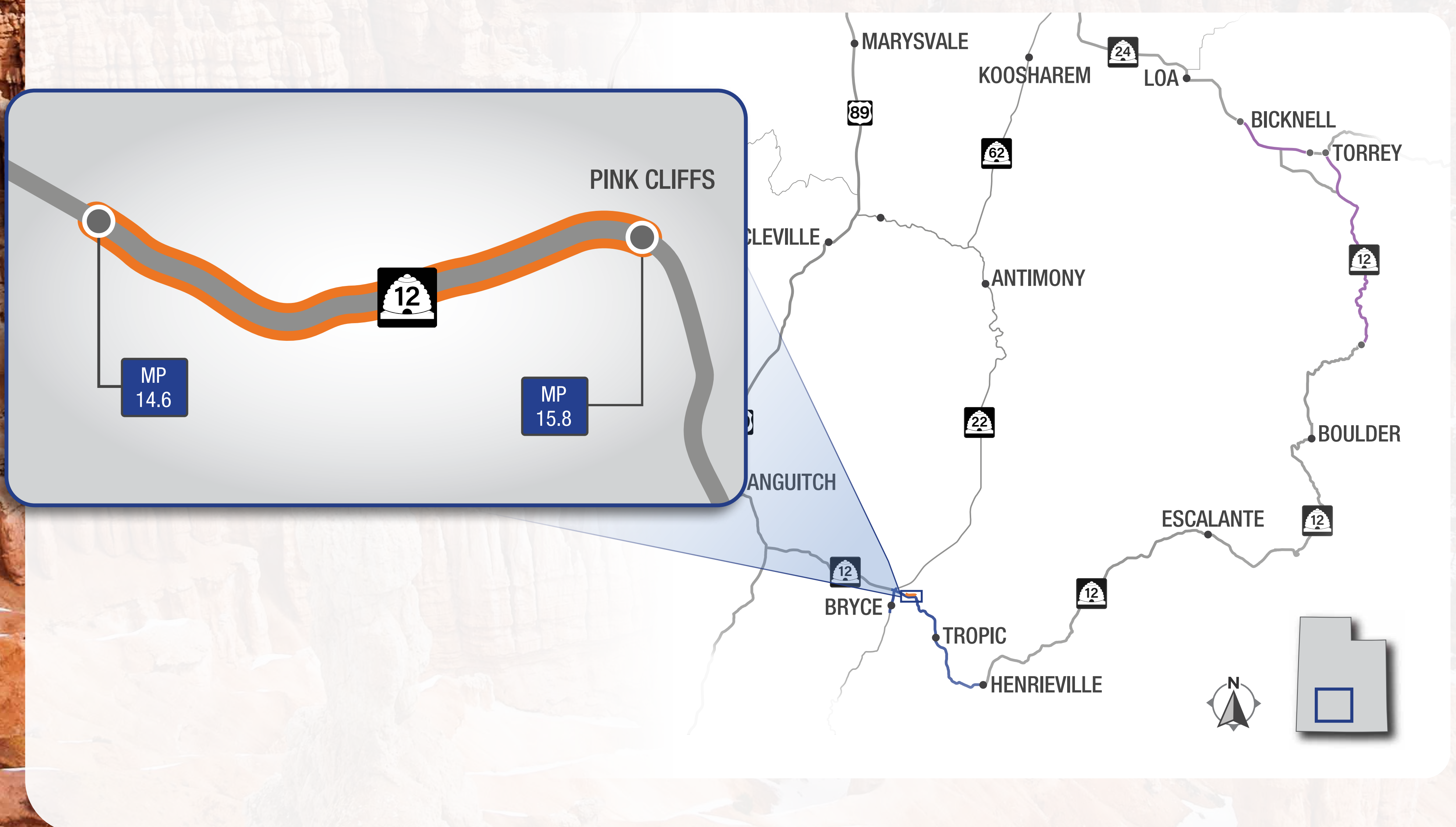
## PROJECT OVERVIEW

In August 2020, UDOT started construction on a 1.25-mile section of S.R. 12 near Bryce Canyon National Park. The project will enhance safety of the corridor by adding a westbound climbing lane, rehabilitating the pavement, increasing the amount of guardrail, and widening shoulders to increase the distance between bicyclists and drivers.

When construction resumes in spring 2021, drivers can expect single lane closures with alternating traffic and delays of up to 15 minutes during daylight hours (8 a.m. – 7 p.m.). Construction is expected to be completed in August 2021.

## Improvements

- Rehabilitating 1 mile of pavement
- Constructing a new westbound climbing lane
- Installing guardrails and other safety features
- Widening shoulders
